



### Eclipse Glasses Return Instructions

Thank you for participating in this special recycling collection!

1. Sort through the eclipse glasses, looking for contamination (e.g. from food/drinks) and obvious damage.

Look at both lenses and frames for:

- Scratches
- Bends/folds
- Punctures/holes
- Torn cardboard or broken plastic

Both cardboard and plastic frames are acceptable. We are accepting ECLIPSE GLASSES ONLY. Please do not include event flyers, stickers, merchandise, or other giveaways from your event.

2. **Package damaged glasses in one box, and good condition glasses in another box.** Boxes should have a lid or be taped closed so we can stack them (i.e. no open lids or bags). If you received a box from the Solid Waste District, please return it to us for reuse.

(Damaged glasses will be taken to a specialty recycler capable of separating film from paper. Usable glasses will be saved and sent to Astronomers Without Borders to be used at future eclipse events around the world.)

4. Complete the forms below, print and attach it to your boxes.

5. Deliver your boxes to the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District. Return no later than July 1, 2024.
