Friends of Cleveland Heights-University Heights Public Library	install recycling containers at PEACE Park and introduce public recycling at Lee Road Library Branch	\$ 24,600.00
Gardenview Horticultural Park	launch an on-site compost program to keep yard waste from going to the landfill and provide educational opportunities for guests.	\$ 3,401.43
